GENERAL INFORMATION

GOLF ETIQUETTE

There are four main areas of etiquette, which are **Course Care**, **Safety**, **Consideration for Others** and **Pace of Play**.

- All players should be mindful of all aspects of Course Care including repairing pitch marks and replacing divots. For additional information please refer to: (www.golf.org.au Rules & Handicapping – Course Care)
- Before playing a stroke, ensure that no one is in your line of play or near your swing. Try not to move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
- In the interest of all golfers, players should play without delay.
- Players searching for a ball only have 2 minutes - allow other players coming up to pass them; they should signal the players following them to pass, and should not continue their play until those players have passed and are out of range.
- Through the green, a player should ensure that any turf cut or displaced is replaced at once and pressed down. **A sand bucket MUST** be carried at all times and used to repair divots.
- Emptying of the cup must be attended prior to the flagstick being replaced in the hole before players leave the putting green.
- When the result of a hole is determined, players should immediately leave the putting area.

PRIORITY ON THE COURSE

- In the absence of special rules, two-ball matches should have precedence over and be entitled to pass any three or four-ball match.
- A single player has no standing and should give way to a match of any kind.
- Any match playing a whole round is entitled to pass a match playing a shorter round.
- If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole on the players in front, it should allow the match following to pass.

RULES OF COMPETITION PLAY

- Play is under the conditions determined by Match & Competition Committee, in compliance with the Rules of Golf (golf.org.au) and local rules in operation at the time.
 - Before commencing play, members should inspect the Notice Board for temporary local rules and other information.
 - To be eligible to play competition, players must enter their names on the sheet provided and pay entrance fee before the commencement of their round.
 - Do not hand in your card until you have checked your score and counter-signed the card. All competitors' cards **MUST** be returned immediately on completion of play.
 - Always pick up when you have lost a hole to par or exhausted strokes allowed in Stableford.
 - Always play without delay: walk briskly between shots.

DRESS AND CONDUCT

Members shall observe proper dress and orderly conduct on the course and within the clubhouse. The suitability or otherwise of a member's attire depends on the particular occasion and there should be no need to instruct members on this point. However, for your guidance, the following points are stressed:

It is a requirement that patrons' apparel be neat, tidy and appropriate to wearing in a Club.

Members are expected to abide by these rules and assist in implementing them.

Please note: Shoes with metal spikes are not allowed.

Special Note for Players

1. All new work is to be treated as Ground Under Repair (GUR).
2. It is a player's responsibility to see that he is playing on the correct handicap.
3. Once a card is checked and counter-signed it is placed in the book and cannot be changed in any way.
4. In the event of ties in special competitions, the Match Committee, in consultation with the players involved, shall determine the manner and times of the playoff.
5. **Starting Times:**
Competition play during the season will start at 12 midday unless otherwise advertised.
 - Players are encouraged to play during competition times.
 - Draw for partners will commence at 11:45hrs.
 - If there are legitimate reasons why players need to hit off earlier, permission should be sought from the Match Committee.
 - There will be a seeded draw for the final round of the Club Championships and players must tee off at the allotted time.

Local Rules:

Tennis court and bowling green

- Left hand side of 1st fairway is **Out Of Bounds** (OOB) as indicated by signs on light poles and pine trees.
- The tennis court, bowling green and the walk way between both are deemed OOB.

If a ball comes to rest within the GUR between the tennis court and the 18th fairway, it must be placed in the **DROP ZONE** located on right hand side of fairway (near pine tree) No penalty shall be incurred.

If playing the 18th hole and the ball comes to rest on the first fairway behind the tennis court or the bowling green, relief must be taken on the first fairway adjacent to the ball's resting position at the nearest point, where the line of flight will not cross either area. No penalty shall be incurred.

Relief may be taken from stones or bare patches to the nearest point of relief no nearer to the hole on the fairway in play. No penalty shall be incurred.

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR ALL PLAYERS:

HANDICAPPING

- **Stroke Par, Stableford and Four Ball Best Ball:** Full Handicap.
- **Foursomes:** Two players play as partners and use one ball. The partners strike off alternately from the tee and thereafter strike the ball alternately during the play of each hole until holed out. Half aggregate stroke handicap.
- **Mixed Foursomes:** Played in the same manner as foursomes except that the Women use the red tees. Half aggregate stroke handicap.
- **Canadian Foursomes:** Played as above except that both players play tee shots at every hole and afterwards continue with whichever ball they nominate. Half aggregate stroke handicap for men and $\frac{3}{8}$ of combined stroke handicap for Women's.
- **American Foursomes:** Both players play tee shots at each hole, and then play a second stroke with their partner's ball. One ball is then selected and play proceeds as in Foursomes with the owner of the ball selected playing the third stroke. Handicap is half of the aggregate stroke handicap for men and $\frac{3}{8}$ of combined stroke handicap for Women.
- **Ambrose:** Played with one or more partners. Each player tees off; the better position of the balls is marked. Players in succession, and in any sequence, place their ball within one club length of this position (no nearer to the hole) and play. The handicap will be $\frac{1}{8}$ of the combined handicap if a group of four, $\frac{1}{4}$ if a group of two. Fractional handicaps are to be used.

HANDICAP CALCULATIONS

Golflink calculates player's handicaps based on competition scores. To view handicap refer to: www.golflink.com.au
Players use a Golf Australia (GA) handicap which is relative to their home course, best 8 of 20 score multiplied by 0.93. When playing at other courses, the GA handicap will be adjusted in relation to the slope rating of the course being played.

COUNT-BACK SYSTEM

Deciding Ties in Events

Ties in events shall be decided whenever possible by replay, but if the

Committee considers this to be inexpedient the following count-back method shall be used:

1. For 18-hole events the best score for the last 9 holes shall be used; if there is still a tie the last six holes, or if still tied the last 3 holes. If a tie still persists then hole by hole from the 18th.
2. In 27 hole events the first 18 holes shall be used; if still tied the last 9 holes and then as for in 1 above.
3. In 36, 54, and 72-hole events the last 18 holes shall be used and still tied count back as in 1 above.
4. In handicap events the relevant handicap or fraction thereof shall be applied.

STABLEFORD SYSTEM OF SCORING

Competitors take the strokes they receive at the allotted holes.

Record the points as follows:

Hole done in net one over par	1 point
Hole done in net par	2 points
Hole done in net one under par	3 points
Hole done in net two under par	4 points
Hole done in net three under par	5 points

The competitor with the highest total of points is the winner.

PAR SYSTEM OF SCORING

Competitors take the strokes they receive at the allotted holes.

Record minus, plus or square as follows:

Hole done in net one over par or more	Minus
Hole done in net par	Square
Hole done in net one under par or more	Plus
